FROM Port Elizabeth International Airport

- Allister Miller Dr, Port Elizabeth, 6070
- Take Allister Miller Dr and Forest Hill N/B Rd to Settlers Hwy/M4
- Follow N2 Cape Town/Humansdorp
- Take exit 748 from N2

[Take Mati Rd to Aggrey Rd in Ibhayi]

- Use the right lane to turn right onto Uitenhage Rd/R75
- Turn Right onto Chase Dr/Mati Rd New Brighton
- Continue onto Ntshekisa Rd New Brighton
- Turn Right onto Aggrey Rd Arthur Wellington
- Aggrey Rd; Ibhayi, 6200

FROM GRAAFREINET FOLLOW PORT ELIZABETH SIGNS

Continue driving past Uitenhage. Do not enter Uitenhage

Follow Port Elizabeth signs and drive slowly at 100 km per hour

Drive past traffic lights between KwaDwesi and KwaMagxaki

Proceed on Uitenhage Road

Drive past Missionvale Campus of Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University on your right

Continue with Uitenhage Road as you drive past a Shopping Centre on your left

Drive past Engen Garage on your right

Continue with Uitenhage Road

Reduce your speed to 60 and keep your left lane

Turn left into Mati Road

Follow Mati Road into Ntshekisa Street

Drive past Police Station on your left

Proceed on Ntshekisa Street

Drive straight through the traffic lights

Keep right lane immediately

Turn Right into Aggrey Road

Drive slowly in Aggrey Road

FROM CRADOCK ABOUT 2 HOURS DRIVE TO PE

Drive past Cookhouse

Drive until you join N2 from East London and Follow Port Elizabeth sign

Drive past Colchester

Follow N2 and drive past Bluewater Bay

The Sea is on you left hand side

Drive past sewage on your right

Follow N2/Humansdorp

Exit N2 into Commercial Road/ Uitenhage Road

Turn Right into Uitenhage Road

Keep right lane

Turn right into Mati Road / which becomes Ntshekisa Street

Drive past Police Station on your left

Proceed on Ntshekisa Street

Drive straight through the traffic lights

After traffic lights keep right lane

Turn right into Aggrey Road

Drive slowly in Aggrey Road
